

CONSTITUTION (AMENDED ON 18 MARCH 2014)

CLAUSE 5 RESIGNATION AND TERMINATION

- 5.1 Any Member-Institution wishing to withdraw from membership of the Association shall do so by providing a written notice of withdrawal two (2) months before the expected date of the withdrawal to the Honorary Secretary and shall settle all outstanding fees upon approval.
- 5.2 Any Member-Institution who failed to uphold the Constitution of the Association or commits any action deemed detrimental to the name and image of the Association, may have its membership terminated or suspended for a period of time as deemed fit by the Board of Management. Before the suspension or termination, that Member-Institution shall be informed in writing of the reasons for the action. That member shall be given the opportunity to explain and to defend itself. Termination or suspension shall be enforced unless otherwise postponed or repealed upon an appeal and a decision at the Annual General meeting;
